FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS ARE AVAILABLE TO HELP PATIENTS GAIN ACCESS TO OFEV

OFEV Commercial Co-pay Program

- Provides assistance for eligible, commercially insured US residents aged ≥18 years and enrollment is handled by the specialty pharmacy
- Patients pay as little as \$0 per month (monthly cap of \$10,000, with an annual cap of \$160,000)
- No physical card to track

OFEV Bridge Program

- Temporarily provides a 15-day supply of OFEV, with up to 3 additional 15-day refills, to eligible patients in case of insurance plan delay
- A payer delay can include a gap in coverage ≥7 days or prior authorization denial

OPEN DOORS® AND THE PERSONAL OFEV CARE TEAM FACILITATES AN INFORMED AND PROACTIVE APPROACH TO DISEASE MANAGEMENT. THE PERSONAL OFEV CARE TEAM INCLUDES:



Nurse Counselor

- Helps patients understand their disease
- Answers patient questions about treatment with OFEV (nintedanib)
- Available 24/7



Social Resource Specialist

- Calls patients periodically to see how they're doing
- Finds local support for patients and/or caregivers
- Helps to identify local social services, like meal delivery, in-home support, or rides to doctor appointments



Case Manager

- Helps patients explore financial assistance options
- Assists in identifying benefits eligibility
- Coordinates paperwork, such as prior authorizations
